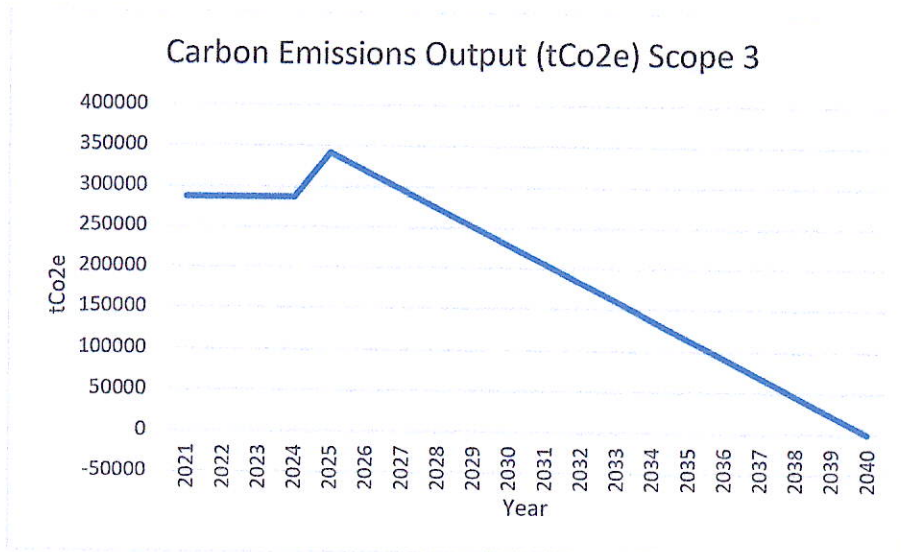
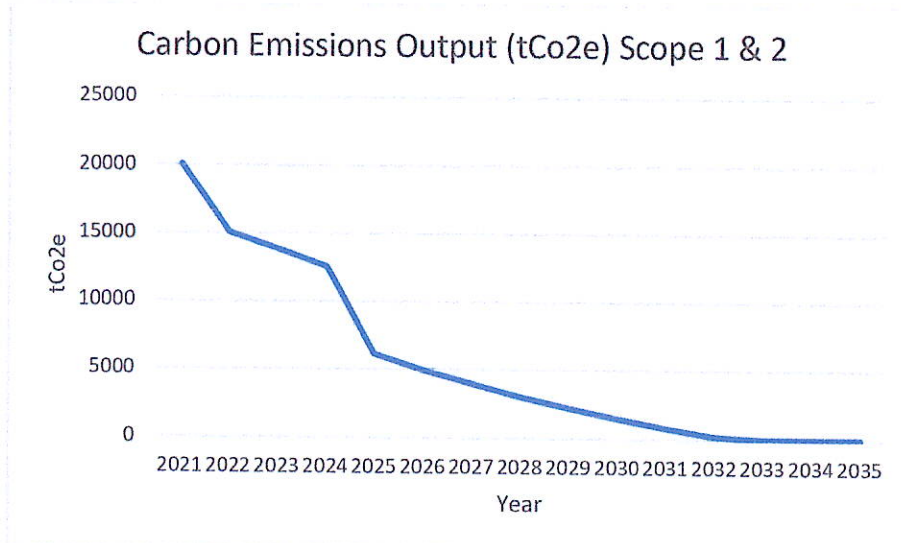
## Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next nine years to 0 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2035 for scope 1 and 2. This is a reduction of 10% year on year (approx.). We have made quite a jump in 2025 to reducing scope 1 and 2, so we do have potential to be net zero by 2033.

We also project our scope 3 emissions to reduce by 7% reach year leading to net zero by 2040.

## Carbon Reduction Projects

### Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since our 2021 baseline:

- Our fleet (company cars) is now fully hybrid.
- We have relocated from our previous office which operated on gas and electricity, to a new office powered solely by electricity.
- We are actively working with customers and our supply chain to reduce food miles.

### Planned Future Initiatives

We intend to explore the feasibility of implementing the following additional carbon reduction measures:

- Discuss transitioning to a renewable energy supplier with our landlord.
- Explore the potential installation of solar panels with our landlord.
- Upgrade all lighting to low-energy bulbs.
- Reduce standby power consumption by turning off unused equipment and introducing a policy to support this.
- Introduce an employee car-sharing policy where feasible.
- Implement improved recycling processes and establish food-waste monitoring.
- Encourage virtual meetings or adopt “meet-in-the-middle” travel arrangements.
- Commit to the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi).
- Explore Cycle to Work and electric vehicle salary-sacrifice schemes.
- Refine our calculations of scope 3 categories.

## Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
